






St Mary Finance Council Minutes



Location: St Mary's School

Date: Thursday, May 18, 2023

Attendees: Dean, Paul, Dan, Tim, Cathy, Barb & Dave; absent Fr Jones

Time: 6:00 pm

I. Opening Prayer @ 6:10 pm by Dean

II. Old Business

- a) Set Ablaze-Barb handed out and advised of Fr Kuhn's letter to pastorate parishes. Also gave insert from Diocese about Set Ablaze which states the biggest role we have now is to pray –pray for the priests and parishioners as we begin this Initiative. Also advised council of website setablazesf.org under the FAQ area is good help too.
- b) Maintenance Report-David advised that he found 2 cisterns near hall, seem hazardous. Dave to get assessment for filling. Grasshopper lawnmower is still available, a few hits but nothing definite yet. Dave reported that the water buildup area in closet near coffee pots in the Hall is due to a broken pipe. Iron Wheel installed a shut-off valve, will eventually run new pipes along wall rather than dig up the cement. Concerns shown for cement steps to Sacristy, Dave advised parts of steps are eroding away and he will try to repair as best he can, Paul offered Dave good advice in repairing. Council approved for Dave to begin this summer in tilling and landscaping the front/east side of church for beautification reasons. Aubyn Schmidt has been hired, part-time, for help in weed eating at the cemetery to help Dave.
- c) School Report -Last Day for students 5.19.23 and last day for teachers 5.25.23. End-of-year Family meal for parents, students, teachers and alumni will be held on Friday, May 19th. Teachers will be in classrooms to pack up their items from Monday, May 22 thru Thursday, May 25th. Teacher severance was discussed and to be paid next week. Advised that teachers were approved to take their laptops with them but must be wiped clean of any confidential information. Per email they denied Diocese help and will obtain their own help. Peggy gave end of year worksheet to teachers to include they must turn in their keys and fobs at end of business on Thursday, May 25th. Prior to Finance meeting, Masey Peccholt, representing the McCook Central School district who walked through and checked out school building for possible use next school year. Maggan previously emailed council and Dan advised of next year's #'s that will be in Religious Ed. for St Mary. Council to table school building discussion until next priest can weigh in.
- d) Hall water damage claim, status – bid received from Salem Lumber and no 2nd bid coming. Barb to send Salem Lumber bid to insurance.
- e) 2023-24 Budget – Reviewed several line items and Dean to speak with Diocese on changes.

III. New business

- a) April Financials – Questions arose about added account #146 and #201.01; also #3102 and #4100 –School Support, Barb to check with Diocese. Barb to have diocese move ½ of new mower expense from GL #5384 to 5386 per Council request.
- b) Barb –Misc. items- Barb received School Foundation & Frerick Cemetery Fund statements and updated the council of quarterly gains and that Diocese was given information to update GL, Barb advised Vitalant Rep Cheryl Dethlefsen visited and asked if could use a room in school for future Blood Drives, council tabled until new priest arrives for better discussion on what to do with school building, Barb read letter from Bishop DeGrood where he approved closing of school, keeping building properly maintained and preserved for future use, and tasked the parish to help teachers in finding gainful employment, if they desired. Bishop conveyed his heavy heart for the children and families and praised God for the school's history.
