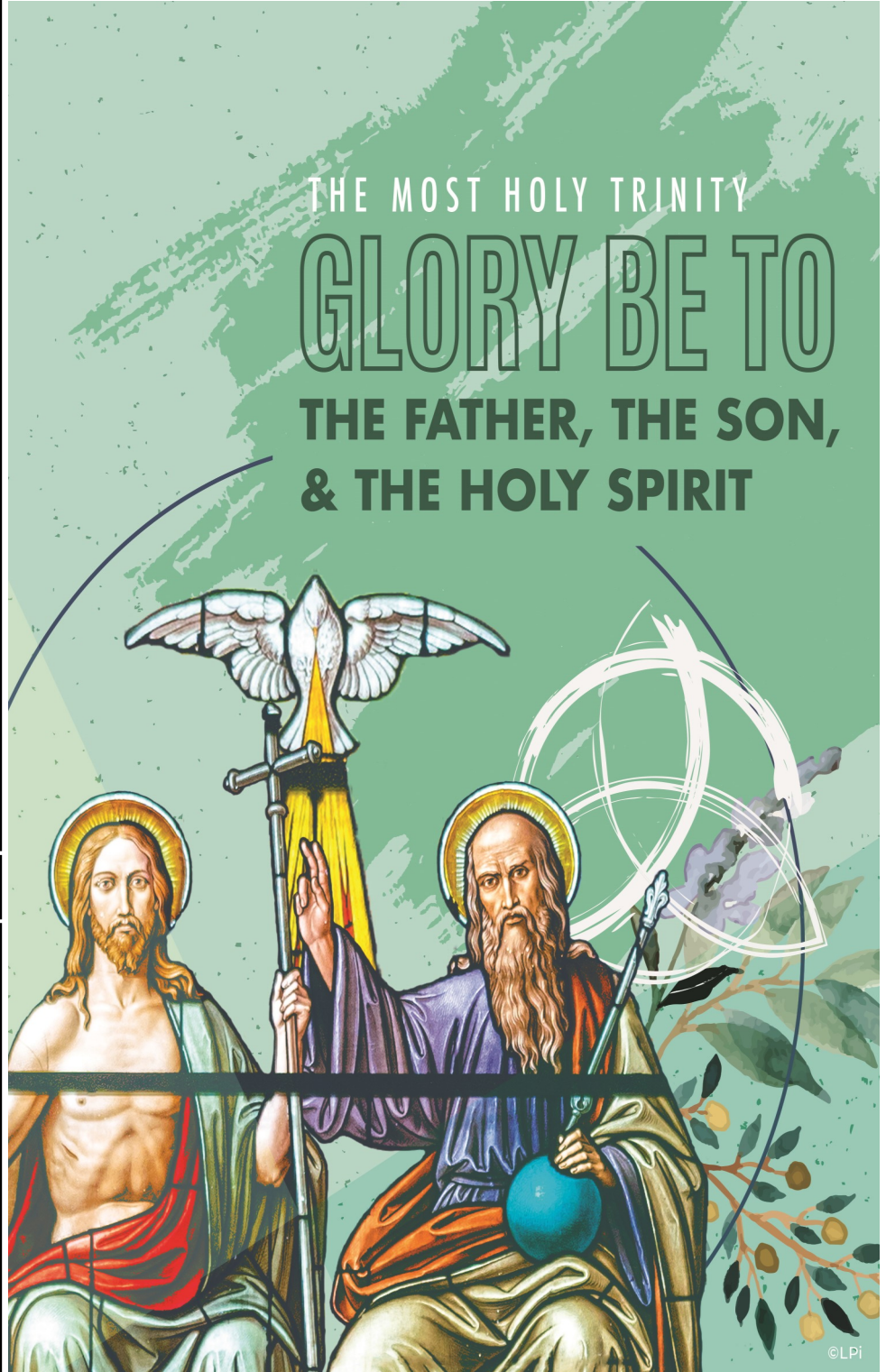

St. Mary's Christian Mothers would like to invite all women to a once monthly study for those that desire to learn more, have questions about or are questioning their Catholic faith.

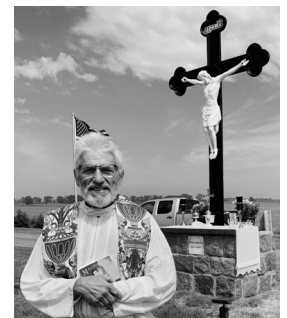
Starting June 16th at 7pm at St. Mary's School

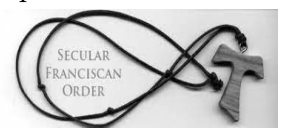

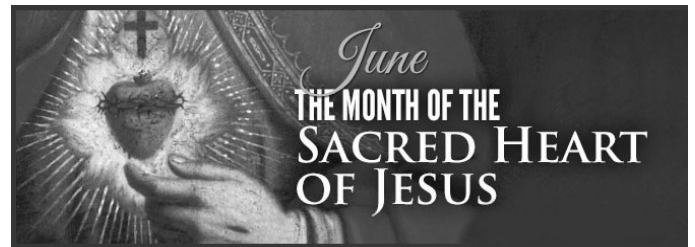
