CONFIRMATION MEETING FOR PARENTS OF ST. ANN'S, ST. PATRICK'S & SALEM, ST. MARY'S.

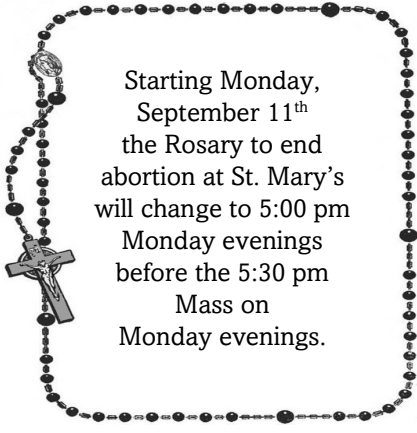
