

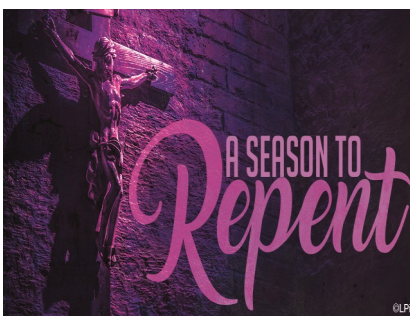

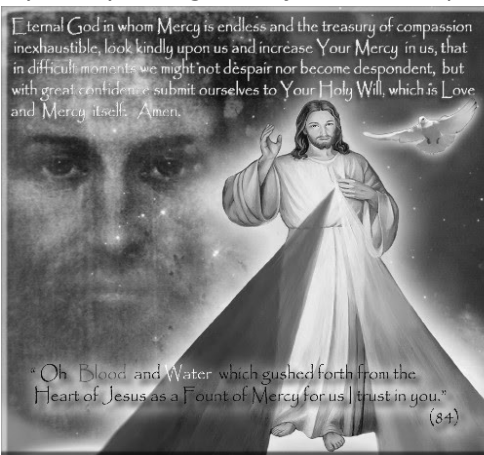

2024 LUMEN CHRISTI MISSIONARY. Jase Heumiller, from St. Mary's Church in Salem, has been accepted to the Sioux Falls Diocese Lumen Christi team this summer. His training will start a few weeks after graduation. His missionary work will involve going to different churches in the diocese and helping with D-camp at Broomtree. St. Mary's School was a large part of Jase's faith journey growing up. However, at the end of his freshman year, Jase attended D-camp. *"The very first day I felt a spark of joy I had never experienced. It felt living and I wanted this feeling for the rest of my life."* The counselors brought enlightenment with small groups & drew out confidence to just be yourself. Jase continued to attend camp each summer. Although the following summer, becoming one of the missionaries was placed upon his heart. Other counselors also recognized a "calling" for Jase and encouraged becoming a missionary disciple. Dealing with the Covid pandemic hit Jase really hard as it did for many. With such an outgoing and fun-loving personality, the seclusion to his house did not fare well and depression set in. With the silence and seclusion, Jase used that time as an opportunity to grow deeper in his prayer life. With this new-found prayer life, he was able to give a confident "yes" to this calling of missionary discipleship. The Lumen Christi missionaries taught Jase to become a "Light" for others. With the gentle prompting from God, Jase is embracing this opportunity as a Lumen Christi missionary by becoming a great servant for Christ & helping others find their way even in the midst of their crosses. THE FEAST
 As a further sign of His Forgiving Love, Jesus called for a Feast of Divine Mercy to be celebrated by the whole Church. He said to Saint Faustina: "I want this image to be solemnly blessed on the first Sunday after Easter, that Sunday is to be The Feast of Mercy. On that day, the depths of my Mercy are open to all. Whoever will go to confession and Holy Communion on that day will receive complete forgiveness of sin and punishment. Mankind will not enjoy peace until it turns with confidence to My Mercy."
THE NOVENA
 Jesus also asked that this Feast of Divine Mercy be preceded by a Novena to The Divine Mercy which would begin on Good Friday. He gave Her an intention to pray for on each day of the Novena, saving for the last day the most difficult intention of all the lukewarmness of souls and indifference of which he said:
 "These souls cause me more suffering than any others, it was from such souls that I felt most revulsion in The Garden of Olives. It was on their account that I said, 'My Father if it is possible let this chalice pass Me by.' The last hope for them is to flee to My Mercy."
