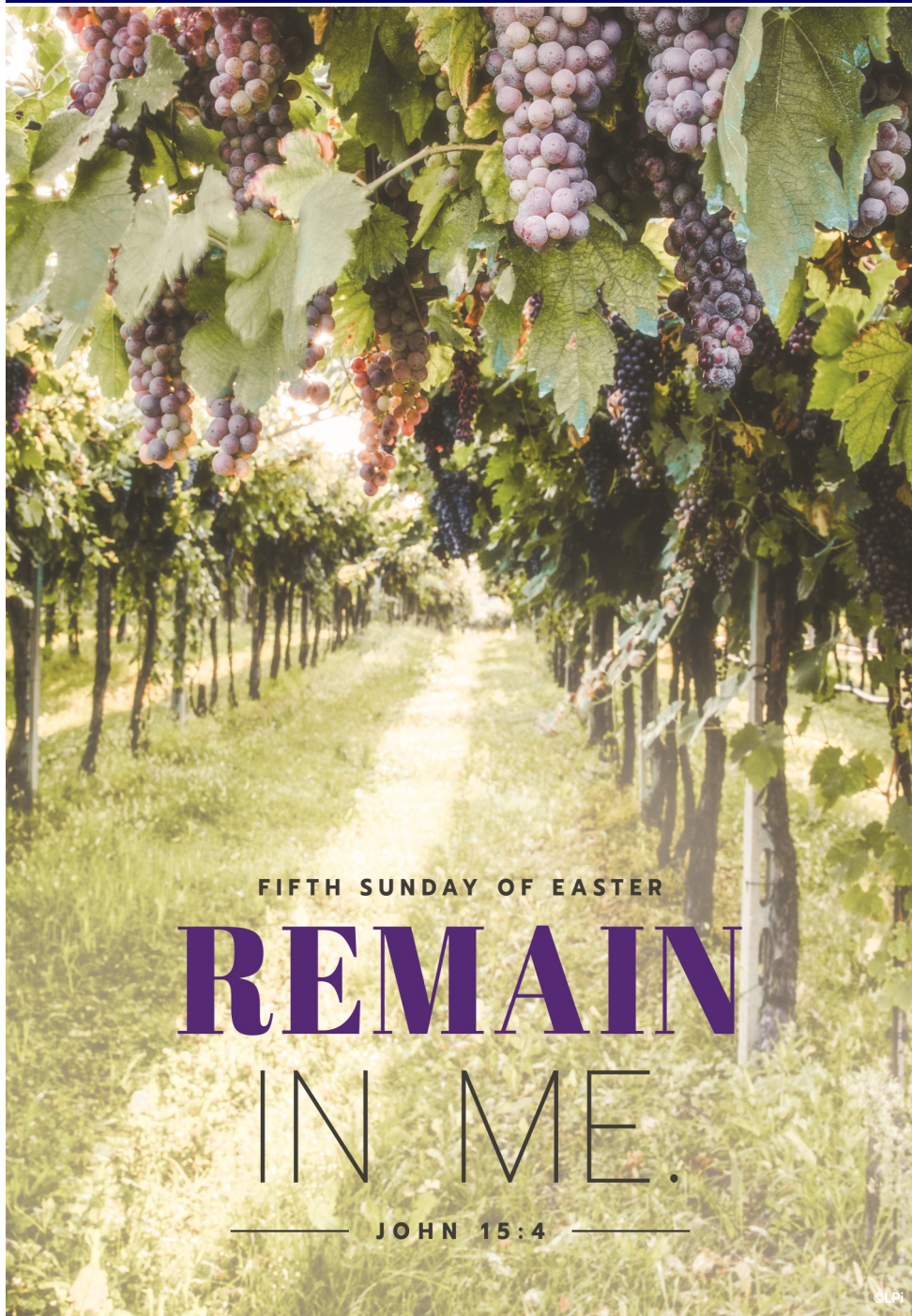

### BACCALAUREATE RECEPTION

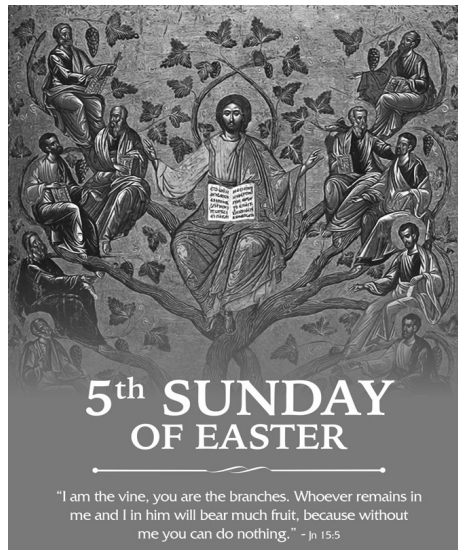
