CCFES Raffle Sales: In conjunction with the 29th Annual Bishop's Charity Fishing Tournaments, The Catholic Community Foundation of Eastern SD partnered with the Knights of Columbus to help with the sales of cash raffle tickets, which 100% of the revenue will help support the current 13 men from the Diocese as they pursue their education and discern their call to the priesthood. The total prize pot for the raffles will be \$5,000. The drawing will be on June 10, 2024 at the close of the Pierre Bishop's Fishing tournament. Need not be present to win! Tickets are \$20 per ticket or \$100 for six tickets. The six ways to win are: 1 @ 1st place-\$2500; 1 @ 2nd place-\$1000; 2 @ 3rd place-\$500; 2 @ 4th place-\$250. They are available from Brian Krempges, GK Salem Council at 605-421-9403, the Salem, St. Mary's Parish office, or check with your local KofC council for availability. At this time no men will be ordained this year and one man is scheduled to be ordained next year. Yet we see many of our priests retiring over the recent and upcoming years.
