



"Billboard" Project with Images of Jesus

The Salem KC's initiated a project to put a billboard type display along Hwy 81, with the Divine Mercy image on one side and a Sacred Heart image on the other. It will be 12 feet tall and 6.5 feet wide, to be made by Avery Brothers in Sioux City, IA. A small mock-up is on display in the back of the Salem church. Some parishioners have graciously agreed to have the "billboard" placed on their property and the necessary permission (variance) from the county has been obtained. The total cost for the "sign" and installation will be about \$10,000, for which we would like to fundraise. If you would like to donate, make checks payable to St Mary's, Salem. Clearly mark donations with the word BILLBOARD. If you use an envelope, it wouldn't hurt to write it on both the check and the envelope. Bishop DeGrood has approved St. Mary Magdalene as the name for this pastorate. This pastorate, then, is now officially "St. Mary Magdalene Pastorate".

As the McCook County Food Pantry works to meet the food needs in our community, it has taken on responsibility for the Backpack program for McCook Central School along with the regular pantry service. Each bag contains the following items: (1-15 oz. THE SIGN OF THE THE FIFTEEN MOST

We often make the Sign of the Cross as we begin and end our prayers, when we celebrate the Holy Mass, for others when they leave their homes or before driving their cars, or even when passing by a church. Actually, the Sign of the Cross is in itself a very short prayer. With it, we appeal to God to make our prayers worthwhile and at the same time, we profess two truths: the first is the deepest mysteries of the Christian faith which is the Holy Trinity the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. When we say "In the name of", we profess that we believe that there is one God. POWERFUL WORDS IN THE We don't say "In the names of" stating it in singular and not plural. When we say, "the Father, and of the Son, and

of the Holy Spirit", we state that we believe that in one God there are three Divine Persons. The second truth that we profess is the saving work of Christ on the Cross. This is shown as we trace the cross from our forehead to our breast and from our shoulder to shoulder. This short prayer of words and action is not just a statement of our belief, but it is a vow to defend that belief, even if it means taking our own cross to follow Jesus, our Lord and Savior.
