July 16: Evening Mass (6:30 pm) at the Carmelite Convent in Alexandria:

It is a special honor and benefit to have a Carmelite monastery in our diocese, and a particular privilege to have it in Alexandria, i.e., in our pastorate. Many great saints have come from the Carmelite order. Cloistered Carmelites truly sacrifice their whole life to the Lord, leaving nothing for themselves. This offering of their whole life is made for the good of the Church, for our good. It is a very special vocation which our Lord Himself is not only pleased with but He Himself wills it. This complete sacrifice to our Lord and Holy Mother draws down the aid of God (grace) for others. Man has so many plans, believing too often that he can make the world good by his own power, his own will. He so often forgets that without the grace of God he is only chasing his tail, it is all for nought. Thanks be to God that He has given us faithful religious who intercede for us day and night.

July 16 is the Feast of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel. Of course this is a special Feast for the Carmelite Sisters in Alexandria. On Tuesday, July 16 there will be an extra Mass at the Alexandria Carmel which will conclude the Sisters' Novena to Our Lady of Mt. Carmel. Reverend Mother Mary Baptist, the Superior for the Carmelite convent in Alexandria, invited me (Fr. Kuhn) to be the main celebrant at that Mass and I would like to invite all of our parishioners to participate. The Church offers a plenary indulgence for those who visit a Carmelite Chapel on the feast of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel. Enrollment in the Brown Scapular will also be offered after the Mass. Scapulars will be supplied. Do you want to do something for: yourself? your family? your parish? the Church? our Lord? This is a great opportunity to do exactly that. Unless the Lord builds the house, as the Psalm says, in vain does the builder build.

Our thanks goes out to Reverend Mother and all the Carmelite Sisters of Alexandria for their vocation and this opportunity to draw close to the Lord and His saints.

Fr. Kuhn Away From the Pastorate For Several Weeks.

I plan to take some time off from July 17 to August 7. I haven't seen my brothers and sisters for 2 1/2 years, since our mom's funeral. So I plan to go back and visit them. I also haven't taken time off in the last 2 1/2 years and a little break is needed -- some time for silence, solitude, and extra prayer, which is how I hope to spend at least the first week. I hope to use my first week as something like the annual retreat required for priests every year.

Please do not leave voicemails on either my office or rectory phone during this time. For baptisms, anointings, and funerals, either contact the parish office (605-425-2600) or Fr. Hamak at the Emery rectory (605-449-4374).

Arrangements have been made for substitute priests so the full schedule of both weekday and weekend **Masses** will be maintained during my time off -- **WITH ONE EXCEPTION:** the Monday evening Mass in Salem on July 22 is canceled because no priest is available to take it. In the event that any other weekday Mass needs to be unexpectedly canceled (e.g., because of a funeral or priest illness) notices will be posted.
