

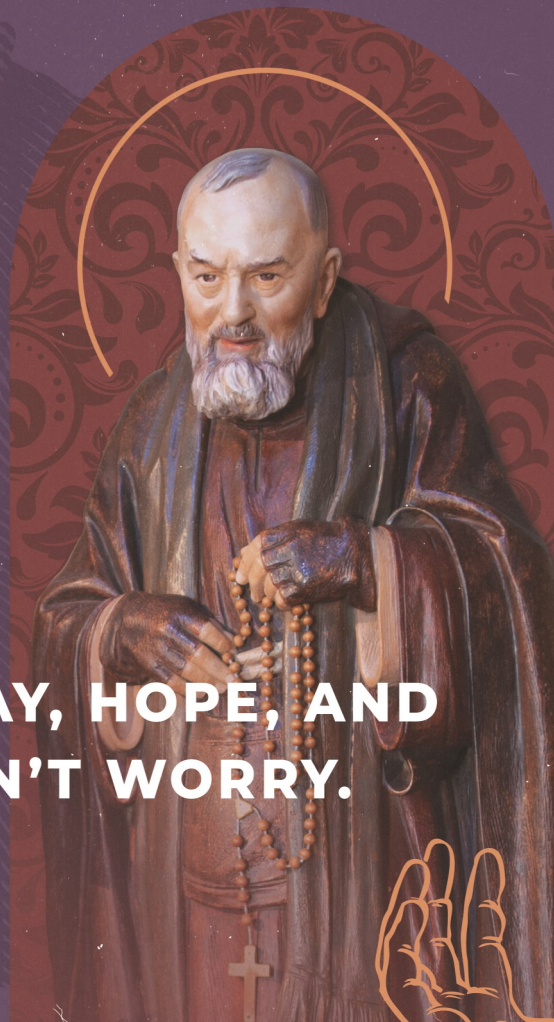

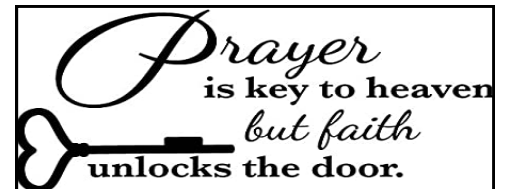

Fr. Kuhn Away From the Pastorate For Several Weeks. I plan to take some time off from July 17 to August 7. I haven't seen my brothers and sisters for 2 1/2 years, since our mom's funeral. So I plan to go back and visit them. I also haven't taken time off in the last 2 1/2 years and a little break is needed -- some time for silence, solitude, and extra prayer, which is how I hope to spend at least the first week. I hope to use my first week as something like the annual retreat required for priests every year.

Please do not leave voicemails on either my office or rectory phone during this time. For baptisms, anointings, and funerals, either contact the parish office (605-425-2600) or Fr. Hamak at the Emery rectory (605-449-4374).

Arrangements have been made for substitute priests so the full schedule of both weekday and weekend **Masses** will be maintained during my time off -- **WITH ONE EXCEPTION:** the Monday evening Mass in Salem on July 22 is canceled because no priest is available to take it. In the event that any other weekday Mass needs to be unexpectedly canceled (e.g., because of a funeral or priest illness) notices will be posted. God bless you, Fr. Kuhn.

ST. MARY MAGDALENE PASTORATE WOMEN'S BOOK STUDY

Starting the month of September, a women's book study will be offered to the entire pastorate.

Women will sign up to read the book suggested. Signing up will be very important, as this will determine the group discussion locations.

A group discussion on the entire book will have 2 options each month for location and time. Location will depend on which parishes have women sign up, but it will not depend on who has the most participants. Times will be Tuesday evenings and Thursday mornings.

The studies will not be set once a month or bimonthly, as some books levels will only require one month to read, while others will take longer. A diverse genre of books will be offered to welcome women at all stages in their faith journey.

The participants can order their own books or the pastorate can order for them if notified in advance.

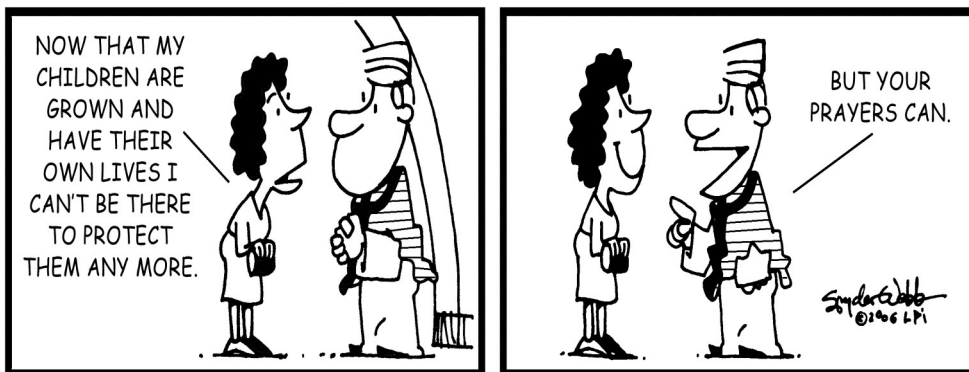
The first book will be announced in early August.
