YOUTH RELIGIOUS EDUCATION INFORMATION FOR THE PASTORATE: With the summer winding down, I wanted to update parents of the pastorate of a few small changes for parishes this year.

ONLINE REGISTRATION REQUIRED: This year, an online child registry has been created for all the religious ed programs in the pastorate. This is a necessary step to help the administration coordinate the RE programs and have updated information for good communication. *All parents* of RE must complete an online registry for their children in our Pastorate. St. Ann's, St. Patrick's, St. Mary's - Salem, St. Martin and St. Mary's - Alexandria will have their own online link for parents to register.

RELIGIOUS ED CANCELLATIONS: There are times that religious ed will need to be cancelled due to weather or other emergent circumstances. Instructions to sign up for the cancellation announcements are in the notes of the online registration form for your parish. It is important that **all parents** sign up, so they do not miss the cancellation announcements.

An email with the registry links has already been sent to parents of each parish that had children registered last year. If you have not received the email or need to register a new child, please contact Maggan Krempges at mkrempges@salematholic.org or 605-425-2600 for the required information.
