

ST. MARY MAGDALENE PASTORATE WOMEN'S BOOK STUDY: Starting the month of September, a women's book study will be offered to the entire pastorate. Women will sign up to read the book suggested. Signing up will be very important, as this will determine the group discussion locations. A group discussion on the entire book will have 2 options each month for location and time. Location will depend on which parishes have women sign up, but it will not depend on who has the most participants. Times will be Tuesday evenings and Thursday mornings. The studies will not be set once a month or bimonthly, as some books levels will only require one month to read, while others will take longer. A diverse genre f books will be offered to welcome women at all stages in their faith journey. The participants can order their own books or the pastorate can order for them if notified in advance. The first book will be announced in early August.
