

CATHOLICISM FOR ADULTS: There will be a class on Catholicism, open to everyone – especially everyone in the pastorate, beginning Sunday, September 15. This class will run 6 to 7 months, meeting once a week:

Sunday evenings, 5:30 pm - 7:00 pm St. Mary's, Salem - in the school building

•Go to your left when you come in the main doors, last room on the left. For those who might be worried, you don't have to share your feelings, or your story, or anything else. Just come and listen. Of course, questions will be welcome. This will be an actual class on what God has revealed - not opinion, or personal thoughts or feelings. Topics covered will be things like: some aspects of human nature, the Trinity, the Church, Revelation (Scripture & Tradition), each sacrament, the person of Jesus, the Passion, gifts of Holy Spirit, grace, moral theology, and others. This class will be used for RCIA as well. While it is an overview of the faith, topics will be covered with some depth, i.e., at least a little more than what you received in school or CCD. In order to forge and deepen relation with anyone we have to get to know them and the same is true for relation with God. If we want to get to know Him, we have to learn what it is that He has told us about Himself - through both His words and actions. •If child care is needed, let us know and we will see if something can be arranged. As our Lord said to the Apostles: Come and see! Hope to see you there. God bless you, Fr. Kuhn.

Becoming Catholic? Curious about the Catholic Faith?

Much of the process of becoming Catholic is simply attending classes. Classes begin Sunday, Sept. 15, at 5:30 pm in St. Mary's school building in Salem; they will run for about 6 to 7 months. If child care is needed, let us know. There is no commitment until the Easter Vigil next year. So if someone wants to just come and listen, that's perfectly ok. There will not be (and cannot be) any pressure to become Catholic -- it has to be a free choice, something you believe in and want to do. All people of good will are welcome. God bless you, Fr.
