

EXTRA MASSES FOR ALL SOULS DAY, Nov. 2: All Souls Day (Nov. 2) is not a Holy Day of Obligation. Nonetheless, the Church encourages Mass for the Holy Souls in Purgatory especially on this day. The most charitable thing you can do for your deceased relatives is offer Mass for them. Since All Souls Day falls on a Saturday this year, it restricts our scheduling somewhat. There will be 4 All Souls day Masses offered this year: 9 am Salem; 9 am Emery; 9 am Humboldt; Noon Alexandria. Note, though, that none of these satisfy the Sunday Mass obligation. They are extra Masses to pray for our dearly departed.

<u>St. Mary (Salem)</u> Sunday, 10:30 am every week, no Saturday evening.

When the last day of the month is a Saturday, the Sunday Mass determines the time & day of Mass. Whoever is scheduled for Sunday, gets Sunday and the other parish gets Saturday night.

<u>Example</u>: in September St. Ann (Humboldt) is scheduled for Saturday night, St. Patrick for Sunday. If September 30 falls on a Saturday, then St. Ann has Sunday and St. Patrick has Saturday evening (on Sept. 30) because St. Ann is scheduled for Sunday that weekend (October 1 and October is an even month).

This coming FRIDAY, NOV. 1, IS ALL SAINTS DAY and is a Holy Day of Obligation. Below is the Mass schedule for the Holy Day. There are 2 Vigil Masses (Oct. 31); the latter time (7:30 pm) is an attempt to accommodate trick-or-treaters. The scheduling reflects an attempt to make Mass as available as possible for as many people as possible. Different times for adjacent parishes hopefully helps minimize the distance anyone has to go for a feasible Mass time. There is one morning Mass, which is about as centrally located in the pastorate as can be. These will be the only Masses for both Thursday, Oct. 31 and Friday, Nov. 1.

SERVER PRACTICE -- FOR ALL SERVERS: There either is already or will soon be a sign-up sheet in the back of the church for server practice. There will be some small changes in serving practices so BOTH current servers and new servers will need to sign up for a practice session. Only those servers who come to a practice will be assigned as servers -- the list of those who come to a practice will be the new list of servers.

For current servers, this will not be a long practice and we can have any number of current servers come to practice at once. Current servers will only go over the changes. There will be a couple of dates offered for current servers.

For new servers: those currently in 4th grade and up are eligible. The goal is to have 3 (minimum of 2) practice at one time so they can actually walk through the Mass like they will do on weekends. So up to 3 kids can be signed up for a given time slot / practice session. Please don't add names beyond that.

Parents: please provide your contact information. There are notes and these will be emailed to parents, in addition to the hard copy that kids will get when they come to practice.

With the number of parishes, the expected number of kids per parish, and the limited number of days available for scheduling, it became clear that the priests were not going to be able to do the server practices in any kind of timely fashion. There is one lay person, then, who will be leading server practices at each parish: Alex Kayser (St. Mary, Alexandria), Jack Catron (St. Martin, Emery), Aaron Carlson (St. Ann, Humboldt), Denny Vogel (St. Patrick, Montrose), and Steve Leber (St. Mary, Salem). I'm very grateful for their willingness to help.

One last important note: for Epiphany and St. Stephen parishes -- parents, please have your kids sign up for server practice at the parish you expect to attend. They should probably sign up for one of the new server time slots since serving might be different than what they're used to at their current parish. *God bless you, Fr. Kuhn*.
