

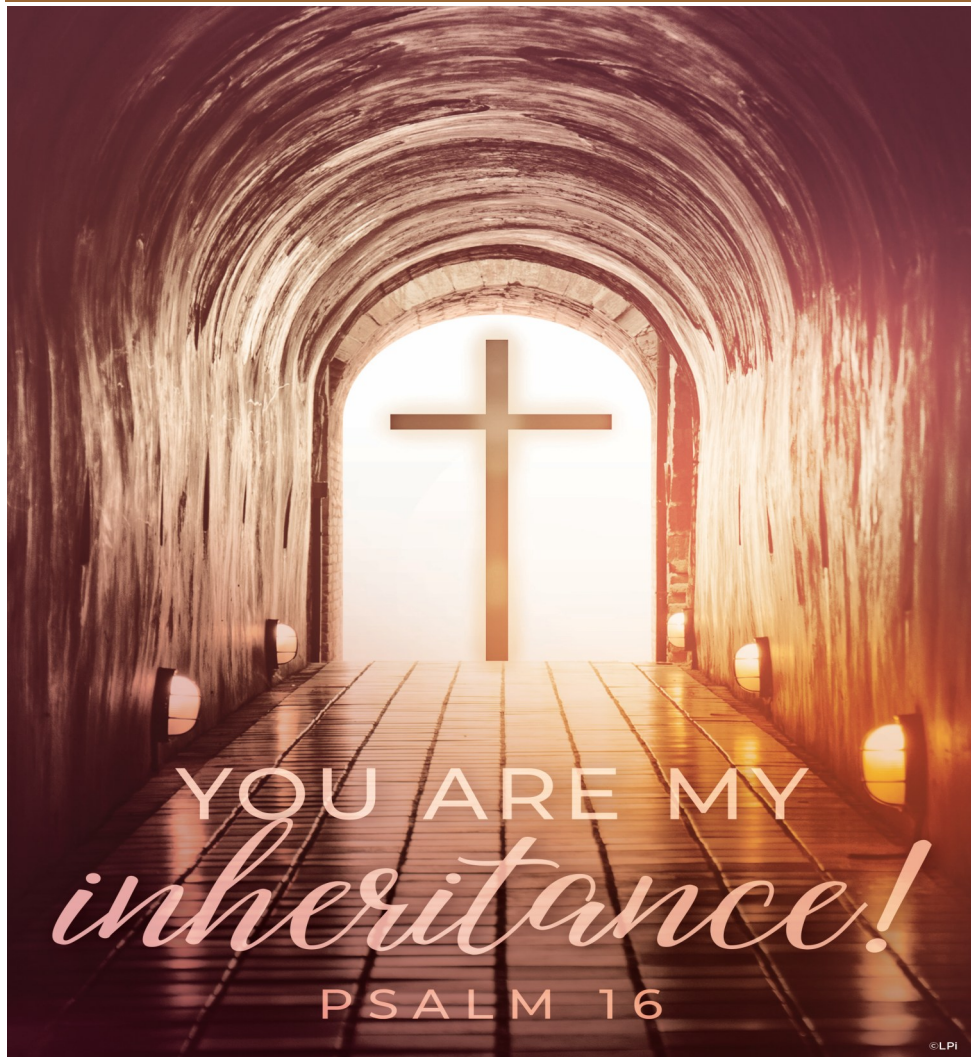

**PASTORATE BIBLE STUDY:** *Revelation: The Kingdom Yet to Come* is an intriguing eleven-session study program. In this study, presenter Jeff Cavins pulls back the veil on the rich symbolism present in Revelation. Discover what the mysterious figures and images of Revelation mean and see how Revelation is more than an apocalyptic vision of the "end times." Explore the Church's teaching on the second coming of Christ and the Last Judgment. Understand how God, the Divine Bridegroom, and the Church, his spotless bride, enter into a heavenly, holy, and mystical marriage every time we celebrate Mass. Workbooks are \$28. Please call St. Mary Magdalene office and get registered so we can order books. Mike Heumiller will be leading this bible study, starting Sunday, December 1, at St. Mary's School in Salem.

**40 Hours Devotion at St. Thomas Aquinas Parish, Madison:** St. Thomas Aquinas parish in Madison will be hosting a 40 Hours Devotion starting with the 10 am Mass on Sunday, Nov. 24 and running through Tuesday evening, Nov. 26. An exact schedule is posted on the bulletin board in each parish. I encourage you to attend. The 40 Hours Devotion dates all the way back to the 1500's. It consists *mainly* (though not solely) of Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament with 40 straight, continuous hours of Adoration, day and night. Confession times will also be offered, as well as talks by Sr. Joseph Andrew Bogdanowicz of the Dominican Sisters of Mary, Mother of the Eucharist. This Dominican order is very faithful and I'm sure the talks will be excellent and thought-provoking. The devotion will conclude Tuesday evening with Benediction (6:45 pm), Mass at 7 pm, and veneration of a relic of St. Thomas Aquinas.

**SERVER PRACTICE -- FOR ALL SERVERS:** There either is already or will soon be a sign-up sheet in the back of the church for server practice. There will be some small changes in serving practices so BOTH current servers and new servers will need to sign up for a practice session. Only those servers who come to a practice will be assigned as servers -- the list of those who come to a practice will be the new list of servers.

For current servers, this will not be a long practice and we can have any number of current servers come to practice at once. Current servers will only go over the changes. There will be a couple of dates offered for current servers.

For new servers: those currently in 4th grade and up are eligible. The goal is to have 3 (minimum of 2) practice at one time so they can actually walk through the Mass like they will do on weekends. So up to 3 kids can be signed up for a given time slot / practice session. Please don't add names beyond that.

Parents: please provide your contact information. There are notes and these will be emailed to parents, in addition to the hard copy that kids will get when they come to practice.

With the number of parishes, the expected number of kids per parish, and the limited number of days available for scheduling, it became clear that the priests were not going to be able to do the server practices in any kind of timely fashion. There is one lay person, then, who will be leading server practices at each parish: Alex Kayser (St. Mary, Alexandria), Jack Catron (St. Martin, Emery), Aaron Carlson (St. Ann, Humboldt), Denny Vogel (St. Patrick, Montrose), and Steve Leber (St. Mary, Salem). I'm very grateful for their willingness to help.

One last important note: for Epiphany and St. Stephen parishes -- parents, please have your kids sign up for server practice at the parish you expect to attend. They should probably sign up for one of the new server time slots since serving might be different than what they're used to at their current parish. *God bless you, Fr. Kuhn.*

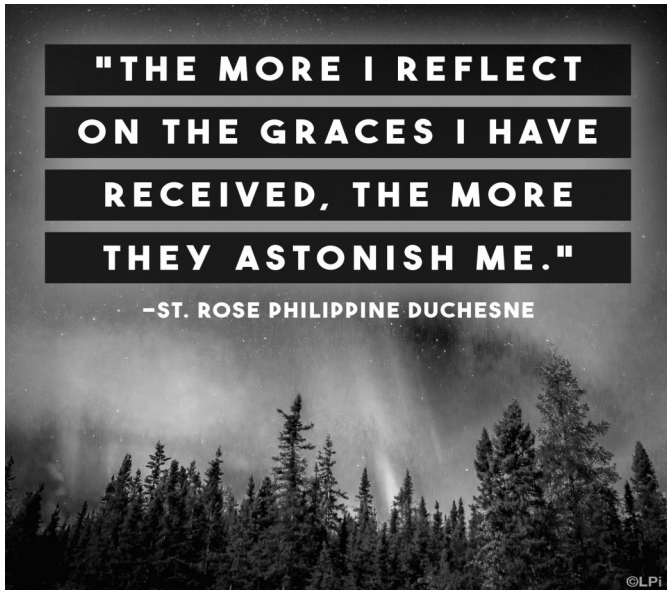
