





**LUMEN CHRISTI INFORMATION:** We have invited Lumen Christi to our pastorate twice this year. This faith filled event is free. If you have any questions please contact Maggan Krempges, DDE, at 605-425-2600 or mkrempges@salemcatholic.org. MAY 31-JUNE 7 IN MONTROSE & JULY 26-AUGUST 2 IN ALEXANDRIA. THE MORNING SESSIONS: Every day starting Monday and running to Friday for grades 1-6. They will start at 8:30am and end at 1:00pm. A morning snack and lunch will be provided every day. Here are a few of the things the VBS program provides for the kids during their morning sessions. Games/ Skits/Fun, 1-2 Catechism Classes on the Summer Theme, 1 Hands On Activity Session, Time for Prayer and Reflection, Saint Stories & Prayer, Teaching and Instruction on the Mass, Recess /Outdoor Activities, Snack. Mass will be made available every morning that week. MORNING SPECIAL EVENT: On Friday, the morning session will participate in a water fight that will last until 2:00pm! THE EVENING SESSIONS: Every day starting Sunday and running to Thursday for grades 7-12. They will start at 7:00pm and end at 9:00pm. A snack will be provided every day. Here are a few things the kids will do during their evening session: Talks, Testimonies, Small Groups, Games. EVENING SPECIAL EVENTS: On Thursday Evenings there will be a bonfire. On Wednesday Evenings we will have a parish-wide potluck starting at 6pm. Then Eucharistic Adoration will be made available for everyone in the pastorate. AFTERNOON OPPORTUNITIES: Our missionaries are available to offer bible/book studies typically in the afternoons or wherever they can fit them in. They set aside time to connect with individuals and follow-up on conversation they've been having throughout the summer. If you know your child would like to take advantage of this opportunity, please mark this down on the registration form. REGISTRATION: Although registration is not required, this will help our missionaries and volunteers prepare items that are necessary for the program. Our Altar Society members from 5 parishes will be bringing the snack and food in for the morning sessions. Registration would also help plan their food preparation. Your child does not have to attend every day. The registration allows you to choose what days your child will be there and if you would like the session in Montrose or Alexandria. If your child is not scheduled for a day, they are still welcome to come if their plans change. Registration will also help me identify the children that will need help finding transportation. VOLUNTEER DRIVERS: Since Lumen Christi is in Montrose and Alexandria, we are looking for parishioners in Humboldt, Salem, Bridgewater, Emery & Epiphany that would be willing to drive kids to these communities. The kids would have to be there at 8:20am and leave at 1:00pm. We recognize that many parents work and it would be very difficult to try to get their children to and from these sessions. Look at your schedule to see if you do have a day off. It does not have to be all week to volunteer. One day may be the one day we need you. You do not have to have a child in the program to volun-Talk with someone in your family or community that may be retired that would love to help working parents out by driving kids to the summer program. EVENING SNACKS: I am looking for people from the pastorate that would be willing to donate bars, donuts, cookies, popcorn, or whatever you like for the evening snacks for the older kids. Again, this does not have to be every day, someone can sign up for whatever day works best for them! If you like and have the time to make something, that would be great, kids love homemade items! Consider someone in your family and community who is a good cook that enjoys baking for kids. Donating money for the evening snacks would allow you to help if you do not have a lot of time. VOLUNTEER AT THE PRO-GRAM: I do need adult volunteers that would help at both the morning and evening programs. This is a guideline set by our diocese. Look at your calendar to see what days you may be available to help out. Again, you do not need to have a child in the program to volunteer and it does not have to be every day. ## PRIEST ASSIGNMENTS/MOVES


