

GOLDEN JUBILEE. Sister Joyce Feterl, OSB, of Sacred Heart Monastery in Yankton, grew up on a small farm near Salem, SD, with her three siblings and parents, Donald and Elizabeth. She was always an “outside” girl who loved the farm, cows, fields, and soil. She attended St. Mary’s grade and high school in Salem until the high school closed in 1969. Several Yankton Benedictines taught her, including S. Ida Holzbauer, who once said, “If you would only go after your books the way you go after a soccer ball!” S. Joyce has always had a strong physical aptitude. She attended Mount Marty College from 1970-1974 with the hopes of becoming a Physical Education Teacher. S. Joyce was inducted into the MMU Athletic Hall of Fame first as an individual in 1984 and again with her 1973 State Volleyball Championship Team in 2012. **“The faith and strength of my parents and grandparents were the biggest influence in my life and my vocation.”** The sisters she encountered in grade and high school and at Mount Marty were also very inspirational to her, entering the Monastery and making first profession in June of 1975 and final profession in July of 1982. S. Joyce taught P.E. in Lincoln, NE, Sioux Falls, and Yankton. After 14 years of teaching and coaching she returned to Mount Marty to study business. She later earned her MBA from the University of Sioux Falls in 1999. She spent 10 years working in the business office for the Sioux Falls Catholic School System and 10 years at Mount Marty University working in the Student Affairs Office. Currently, S. Joyce volunteers at the Habitat Restore in Yankton and at Sacred Heart Monastery. **“Being a Benedictine for 50 years has taught me dependence on God and the need to remain faithful even in tough times. I suppose the biggest factor in staying Benedictine is prayer – you’ve got to keep that going. 
