



PRO POPULO: Listed in the bulletin, in the Mass intention announcements, Pro Populo is used as the intention. The term Pro Populo in Latin means "For the People" and Canon Law, the code of law which governs the Catholic Church, calls for the pastor of a parish to celebrate one Mass each week for the intention of the parishioners. This is an ancient tradition of the Church and of the priesthood, which is required to pray for the people in their charge. The Pro Populo Mass may be celebrated on the weekend or the weekday.
